



The U.S. Consulate General in Ciudad Juarez, Mexico is soliciting bids for (1) one outdoor LED message board.

Specifications:

Minimum lighted display surface: 2400 x 1900

Maximum overall finished size: 2500 x 2000 mm

Minimum LED Pixel Pitch: 4.81 mm (i.e. 4.81mm or closer)

Color: Full-color RGB capable of producing 281 trillion colors or more.

Graphics / Animation: Capable of displaying with no additional requirements.

Video: Capable of displaying with no additional requirements.

Synchronization: Providing digital output signal for synchronization to other devices such as digital LED, LCD, and similar indoor displays.

Internet Connection: Cannot connect to internet or utilize wireless controls; must be self-contained

PC hardware: A new PC, monitor and accessories have to be included with all software installed.

Software: Included. Free updates for five years.

Installation: By customer and under vendor support by phone or other.

Location: U.S. Consulate General, Paseo de la Victoria #3650, Ciudad Juarez, Mexico (opposite El Paso, TX).

Minimum Warranty: 100% parts and on-site labor for first year, including but not limited to electrical, mechanical, and software failures. Breakage, vandalism, and violent weather-related damage excluded (other than normal outdoor weather conditions of rain, snow, sunlight, sandstorm and temperature variations). Hail damage is at the customer's risk. Wind damage above 70mph is at the customer's risk. Second year warranty to cover 100% of the replacement cost of electrical, mechanical and cabinetry components; customer to pay technician travel costs from the continental United States. LED lights warranted for 5 years; replacement lights shipped to customer; no installation or onsite service.

Training: Vendor to provide information, drawings, electrical connections programming instructions and maintenance manuals. Telephone support provided during vendor's business hours for one year from date of award.

Manuals: Operational and service manuals to be provided by vendor. Installation diagrams to be provided by vendor.

References: Vendor to provide at least two references with contact information, including email address.

Due to size and density variations from manufacturer to manufacturer, vendor must specify proposed lighted surface size, finished size, LED pixel pitch, whether or not LEDs are hot swappable, warranty, and training which meet or exceed the specifications.

Customer will provide site preparation that includes pole erection, electrical supply to vendor specifications, conduit for wire control transmission. Customer to supply laborers and craftsmen for installation under remote vendor supervision/support. Customer to supply scissor-lift or similar device to hoist signs into place.

Vendor must identify any additional requirements they expect customer to perform; otherwise, project is intended to be turnkey upon completion of the installation process. Except for customer responsibilities identified herein, price quotation is intended to be all-inclusive for a fully operational system.

All responsible sources may submit a response that, if timely received, must be considered by the Contracting Officer.

U.S. vendors must have a DUNS number and SAM account active. Mexican vendors quoting in U.S. Dollars must possess a U.S. Dollar account in Mexico.
