VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

United States immigration laws require that immigrant visa applicants obtain certain vaccinations prior to the issuance of a visa. Panel physicians who conduct medical examinations are required to verify that immigrant visa applicants have met the new vaccination requirements.

In order to assist the panel physician, applicants should bring any available vaccination records to the medical exam. If there is no vaccination record, the panel physician will work with you to determine which vaccinations you may need to meet the requirement. Only the panel physician will determine which of the vaccinations are medically appropriate for you, given your age, medical history and current medical condition.

The cost of your vaccines will depend upon the type of vaccination(s) that you will need. The vaccination fee is separate from the cost of your required medical examination.

Consulate employees are not authorized to give information in reference to vaccination requirements to the general public. The only authorized agencies to give this information are the panel physicians.
